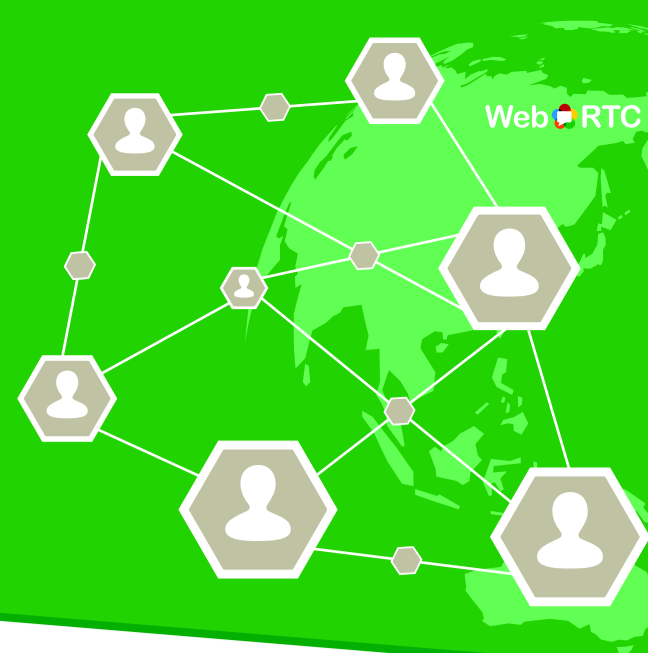


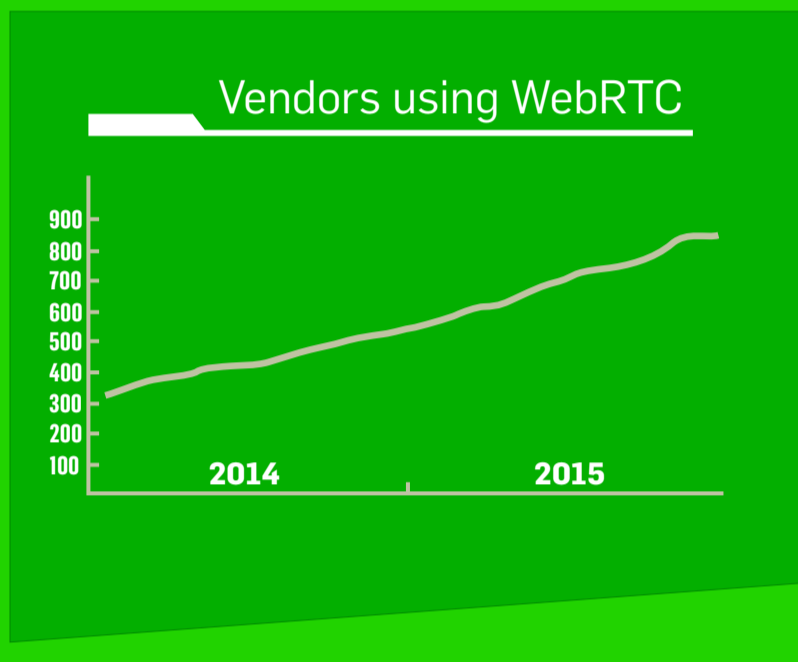

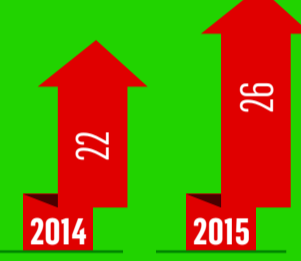

WebRTC Ecosystem Size

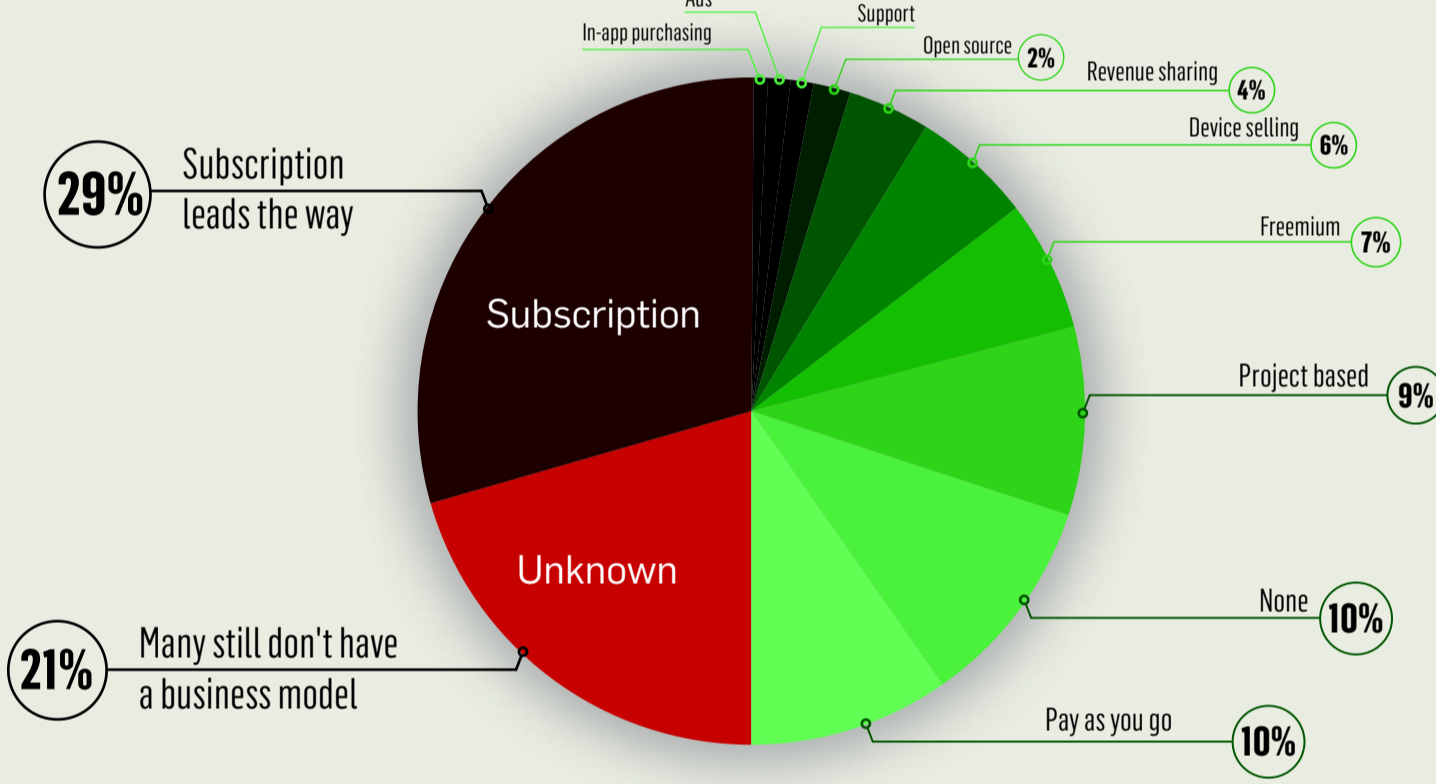


Over 850 WebRTC vendors and projects at the end of 2015.

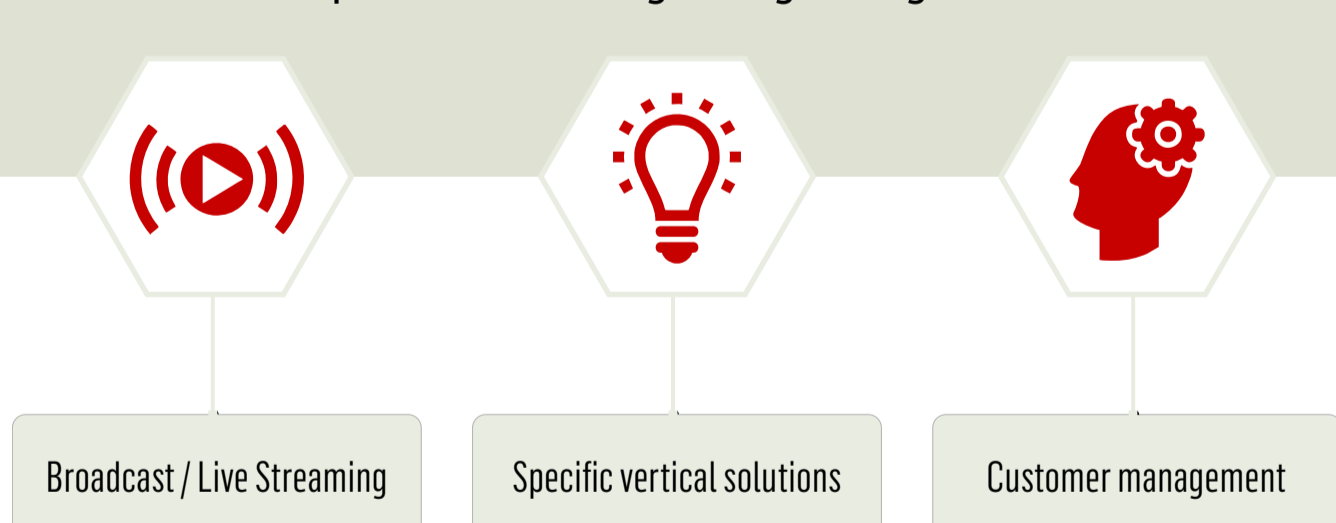

Until end of 2014 | In 2015

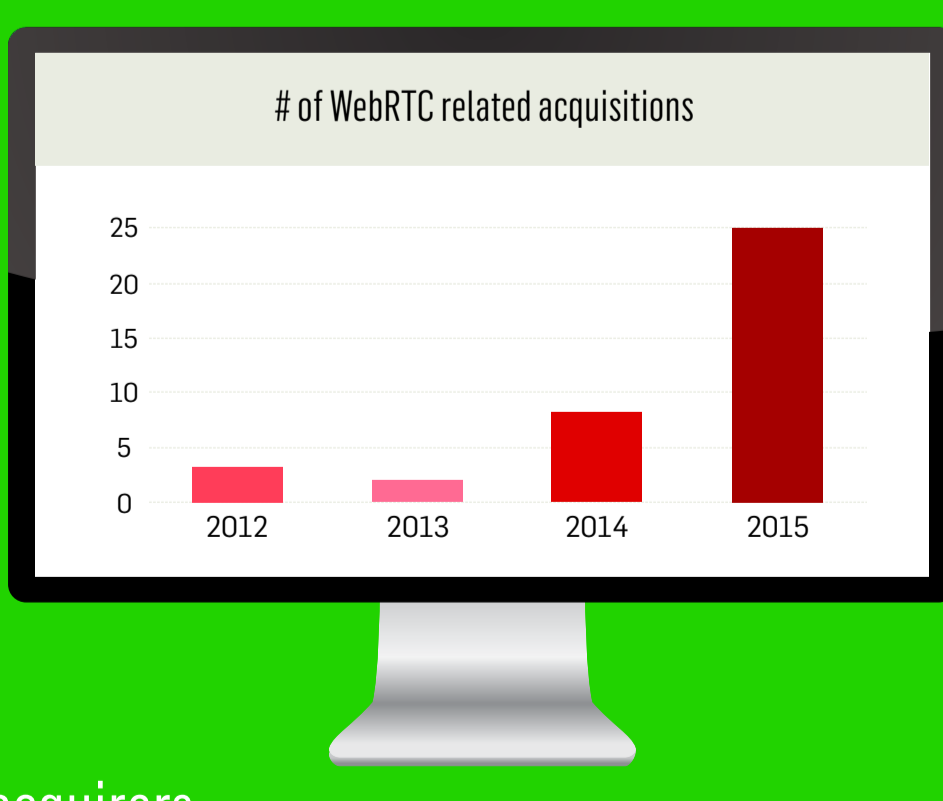


Top 3 WebRTC categories growing in 2015

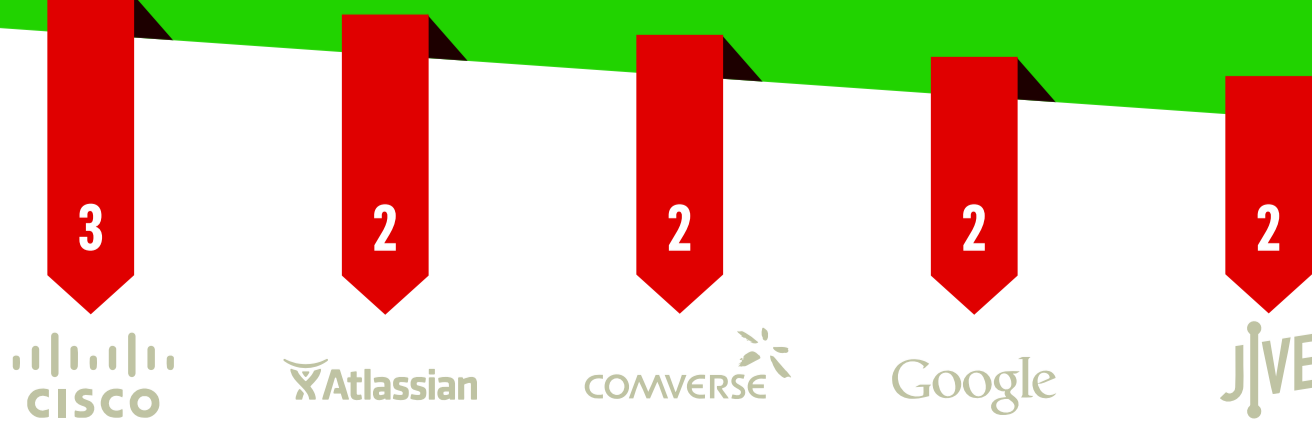
